Grace Cameron Rogers Scholarship

Purpose

This scholarship is awarded to a practicing and/or emerging craftsperson to attend a recognized school or course to upgrade technical or design skills, or to seek a stimulus for greater creativity and inspiration.

As the cost of craft-related education (tuition, materials, travel, accommodation, etc.) can be high, there is an ongoing need for financial assistance to craftspeople to help defray these costs. The principle of the Grace Cameron Rogers Fund is held in trust by the CCBC, and the interest generated is awarded to a deserving member.

The current award is for \$1000.

Eligibility

- Must be a [CCBC](#) member in good standing to apply
- Must be a BC resident.
- CCBC Board Members and paid staff are not eligible. They will become eligible one year after the date of the resignation from CCBC.
- Previous recipients must wait 3 years before reapplying to the scholarship
- Maximum of 2 scholarships awarded per person.

Application Requirements

Please submit ALL the materials listed below via [Slideroom](#) before June 1st, 2023

- A cover letter including an outline of the proposed study and why it would be beneficial to the applicant
- A budget outlining projected expenses and revenue. Indicate pending and confirmed revenue.
- Artist biography and resume/cv
- Digital Images – A maximum of 10 digital images of your work at 300 dpi in .jpg format with dimensions as close as possible without exceeding 3375 pixels high and 2625 pixels wide.
