



## **Call for Entry: Featured Region Program**

### **Requirements**

- The work must be craft (clay, wood, metal, glass, textile, and/or mixed media).
- The work must be handmade. Technically, this means that at least 90% of the work must be crafted by the artist. A great example of this is a cedar woven hat that an artist crafted, and then later incorporated several beads (which the artist did not make) into the work.
- The group must contain between 5-12 artists.
- There must be one person coordinating on behalf of the entire group.
- The artists should be from BC, but CCBC is open to receiving work from Canadian groups outside of the province. Please contact us at [gi\\_shop@craftcouncilbc.ca](mailto:gi_shop@craftcouncilbc.ca) if you are a group who is interested in this opportunity, but not based in BC.

### **Conditions upon Acceptance**

- There must be standards of quality check for all the incoming work, before arriving at CCBC. Ideally, a craftsperson related to the incoming group can perform this check but CCBC is also willing to assist if needed.
- Each artist will be asked to submit a form with information about their work and a short artist bio.
- Each artist must sign the consignment agreement before they can sell work in the shop.
- All the work must be brought to and from the Craft Council of BC at the artist's expense.
- After the program ends, if participating artists are interested in becoming full time consigners with us, they must first become a member, and then go through our Standards of Quality jury.
